There are many reasons why people decide to become a local councillor. They include:

- being concerned about the local area and wanting to ensure that the local community gets the right services and facilities
- wanting to represent the views of local people and ensure that local community interests are taken into account
- wanting to contribute your business or professional skills, or maybe just
- concerns about one particular issue

If you care about the area that you live or work in and the issues facing local people, you can apply to be co-opted onto the Parish Council.

Primarily you need to be over 18, live in the parish or within 3 miles of the parish boundary, or work in the parish and be a British citizen to qualify.
